Be grateful and humble yourself for all that the Lord has done



The following Highlights are from a CNN report on May 16th 2016.

Women who regularly attended religious services also had higher rates of social support and optimism, had lower rates of depression and were less likely to smoke. However, the researchers took into account these differences between churchgoers and non-churchgoers when they calculated the decrease in death rates of 13% to 33%. Attendance could promote self-discipline and a sense of meaning and purpose in life,.... "Our study suggests that for health, the benefits outweigh the potentially negative effects," such as guilt, anxiety or intolerance, VanderWeele said.
